Following the Conference theme & verse, our workshop teachers offer the following:

10.00-11.00am - Paul Haywood, *Flags in a Small Space*

Paul will be exploring how to imaginatively make the best use of the space you have available. Through very practical suggestions, his aim is to facilitate personal worship and intercessory prayer. [NB you will need 2 flags which fit your space. You can buy these from <https://www.kingdomdance.co.uk> or other retailers; borrow from a friend, or contact conference@cdfb.org.uk to borrow from Paul for the day, if you do not have your own.]

11.30-1.00pm - Anna Gilderson, *The Praises of God's People*

Join Anna as she teaches a choreographed dance to *Inhabit* by Leeland. The session will seek to explore and link how Acts 2.46-47 serves as a reminder of the attitude with which we praise God, read his word and respond to serving him with open hearts. There will be moments to create some of your own movement and learn what Anna has created. The dance is suitable for all levels, and movements can be adapted as needed for those that attend. The dance will be choreographed in such a way that if you wish to take it back to your own dance group/ church that would be possible.

2.00-3.00pm - Debby Ward, *Messianic Movement*

Being able to dance a group dance during lockdown has been a challenge not many of us have resolved. Debby will lead us in a series of Messianic movements that we can use alone in our homes or with others, to feel the fellowship of dance even when we are physically apart.

3.30-5.00pm - Anna Gilderson, *When We Gather*

Join Anna for a slower and more meditative session when you will learn movements and respond to words from a poem based on Acts 2.42. The poem is based on the aspect of how we gather, learn and share before God. Including the impact of the breaking of bread and prayer. Part of this session will also include a short reflective time, where you will be encouraged to pause and listen from God.
